Conduct & Discipline Policy

Bright Star UMC PAC staff would like your child to have the best experience possible while at camp this summer. Thus, all participants must understand and follow the camp guidelines and rules. These guidelines and expectations are in place to ensure the safety of your child and staff.

1. Listen to camp leaders and follow directions the first time they are given.
2. Respect PAC staff, other camp participants, and property (belonging to church or anyone else).
3. Keep hands, feet, and other objects to yourself.
4. Participate in camp activities.
5. Clean up after yourself.
6. Be positive and have fun!

Should a participant choose not to follow any of these rules, these are the guidelines that the staff will follow to handle the situation:

Step 1: Verbal Warning.

Step 2: Time out or time away from group.

Step 3: Parent Contact.

Step 4: Meeting with parent(s), child, camp director and necessary camp staff. At this time, suspension or expulsion from camp may be discussed.

In the event that a Camp participant engages in behavior which poses a threat of bodily harm to his or her self, others, or facility property, an immediate meeting with the parent(s), or guardian may be called. If such behavior warrants it, an immediate suspension or expulsion may result. Behaviors that result in this type of disciplinary action include, but are not limited to: stealing, possession of weapons or illegal substances, use of profanity, sexual or verbal abuse, violence (hitting, kicking, biting, etc.) and property damage.

****There will be no refunds of any kind given as a result of a suspension or expulsion due to a violation of the BSUMC Performing Arts Camp Conduct & Discipline Policy.***

Please review these rules with your child. We will also review these rules with your child at the beginning of camp. Thank you in advance for your cooperation, and we hope to have a great summer!
